

Instructions for Consonant Blends
Flip Book Lesson(s)
R-Blend Words

[Br] [Cr] [Dr] [Fr] [Gr] [Pr] [Tr]

1. Print on 8.5 x 11 paper or cardstock. Laminate for future use.
2. Cut out all six rectangles. The rectangles are numbered [1-5] plus the title card.
3. Depending on the age of your child or student, either: 1) put the cards in numerical order (from 1-5) yourself; 2) assist your child in putting them in the correct order if they need help; or 3) have your child do it themselves if they can.
4. Start with having your student look at the pictures and the corresponding Bl-blend words.
5. Next, help them to read **verbally** (out loud) the R-blend word below the corresponding picture according to the directions below.
6. Start with the blend itself. For blends, *both* letters are pronounced: The first card blend word is BRACELLET. BR is the R-blend in the word *bracelet*. See if your student can pronounce the Br blend in the word *bracelet* without saying the rest of the word. "**Brr**"

If they can't, help them by saying it yourself until they are able to repeat after you. "**Brr**" Say the word BRACELLET. Say it slowly at first, so they can hear the BR sound in the word BRACELLET, and then gradually say the complete word as it is typically pronounced. Have them repeat after you.

1. "Brrr-acelet" "Brrr-acelet" "Brrr-acelet"
2. "Bracelet"
3. Continue like this with the rest of the R-blend word Flip Books:
4. [Br, Cr, Dr, Fr, Gr, Pr, Tr].


Flip Book Instructions

1. Put card [5] on the bottom.
2. Put card [4] on top of card [5].
3. Continue like this until you have card [1] on the top and the R-Blend title card on top of card [1].
4. Staple the cards together or punch a hole in the top of each card and use a ring, string or yarn to tie everything together to make the Flip Book.
5. Color the pictures if desired.
